Spectator and Parent/Carers Code of Conduct Season 2019-20

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. This club is supporting The FA's [RESPECT](#) programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything. Play your part and observe The FA's [RESPECT](#) Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play from both sides as well as success
- Always respect the match officials' decisions and coaches from both sides and encourage players to do the same
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning
- When a player makes mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or The FA:

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club or officials
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or County FA Welfare Officer
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued with a fine.

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club.
